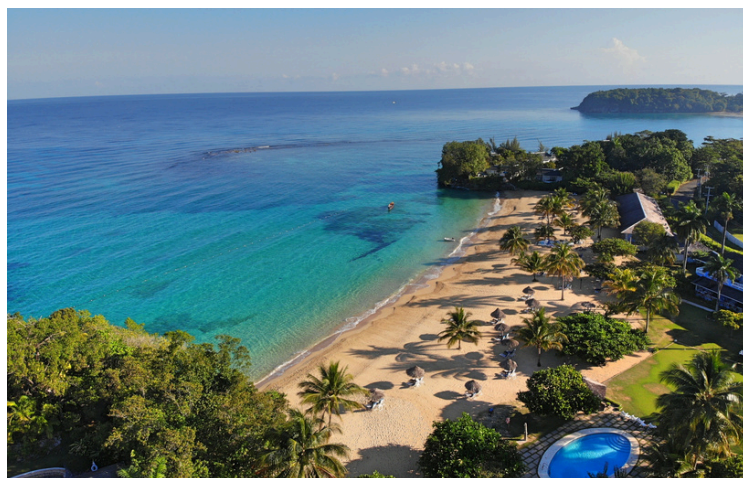

- Jamaica is the third-largest island in the Caribbean, measuring approximately 4,240 square miles (10,990 square kilometres).
- The capital city of Jamaica is Kingston, located on the southeastern coast of the island.
- The population of Jamaica is around 2.9 million people, with a diverse mix of ethnicities including African, Indian, Chinese, and European heritage.
- Jamaica gained independence from British colonial rule on August 6, 1962, and is now a member of the Commonwealth of Nations.
- The official language of Jamaica is English, although Jamaican Patois (Creole) is widely spoken among locals.
- The Jamaican economy is driven by tourism, agriculture (including sugar, bananas, and coffee), mining, and manufacturing.
- Famous Jamaican cultural exports include reggae music, spearheaded by legendary musicians like Bob Marley, and the internationally celebrated Jamaican cuisine, known for dishes like jerk chicken, ackee and saltfish.
- Jamaica boasts stunning natural attractions such as the Blue Mountains, home to the world-famous Blue Mountain coffee, and Dunn's River Falls, a cascading waterfall that attracts thousands of visitors annually.

# TRAVELLING TO JAMAICA & JAMAICA INN

## LOCATION

Jamaica Inn is located on a private cove with an offshore reef two miles east of Ocho Rios town centre and set in 8 acres of pristine beachfront.

## ACCESS

There are three international airports in Jamaica – Norman Manley International Airport, Kingston. Sangster International Airport, Montego Bay and Ian Flemming, Ocho Rios.

The following airlines offer flights from London Gatwick to Jamaica – British Airways (Norman Manley International Airport), Virgin Atlantic (Sangster International Airport), TUI Airways UK, Norse Atlantic, and Caribbean Airlines offer transfer flights from most other islands to Jamaica.

Ian Fleming International Airport, Boscobel- 15 minutes, 13km away for private jets, contact the hotel for full details.  
The Ian Flemming International Airport transfer cost is US\$60 each way.

## CLIMATE

Average temperatures range from 78 degrees F to 85 degrees F (26 degrees C to 30 degrees C)  
Jamaica's tropical climate brings warmth all year round, winter and spring are classed as the dry season and June – November the wet season.

## JAMAICA ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Visitors must have a valid passport and return or onward ticket. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months from arrival into the country and have at least 2 blank pages for entry and exit stamps. However, if you are a British, Canadian or US citizen, proof of citizenship bearing a photograph is acceptable.

## AIRPORT LOCATIONS

Sangster International Airport, Montego Bay to Jamaica Inn is approximately 1 hour 30 minutes.  
Norman Manley International Airport (with the new North/South Highway) to Jamaica Inn is approximately 1 hour 30 minutes.

## AIRPORT TRANSFERS

To ensure a pleasurable airport transfer we recommend a private car, this can be arranged through the hotel or a recommended local agent.  
Guests are urged not to take a bus transfer as this can take twice as long.

Club MOBAY and Club KINGSTON – there are 2 VIP lounge facilities for arriving and departing passengers at Sangster International Airport, Montego Bay and Norman Manley International Airport, Kingston. In addition to the excellent amenities, and complimentary snacks and drinks, passengers have fast-tracked access through security and immigration (escorted on arrival).

# JAMAICA INN FACTS - AT A GLANCE

## CHECK IN / CHECK OUT

Check-in 3:00PM – Check out 12:00PM – although a later check out will be accommodated if possible, on request.  
Accommodation and F&B accounts should generally be settled before 12:00PM.

## CREDIT CARDS & CURRENCY

All major cards are accepted – Visa, MasterCard and American Express (Diners Club not accepted)  
All prices are quoted in US Dollars and money can be exchanged at the hotel reception.  
Jamaican Dollar (JMD), Sterling Pound, Euros & Canadian Dollar are readily accepted.

## MINIMUM STAY - ALL ACCOMMODATIONS

7 nights between 20 December and 01 January in all accommodations. In addition, no departures from the hotel are permitted between 29 December and 01 January. 5 nights between 09-21 February and 17-22 April. Any other time of year 3 nights minimum. Stays of 3 nights or less on request. However, please check with the hotel in case space becomes available for shorter stays during these periods.

## CHILDREN

10 years and older are welcome year-round. Child rate is the same as 3rd adult sharing rate.

## PRE-ARRIVAL REQUESTS

An online guest checklist will be made available prior to arrival, which will allow guests to choose from extra pillows to mini-bar contents and advise any special request to ensure everything is ready for the guests arrival.

## CONCIERGE

On hand to assist guests with requests before and during their stay.

## ELECTRICITY

110 volts AC 50 cycles and the electrical points at the hotel fit 2-pin plugs, so an adaptor is required.

## INTERNET

Complimentary Wi-Fi is available in rooms and public areas of the hotel.

## MEDICAL

On-site nurse and a local Doctor who will make house calls. The nearest hospital is in St. Ann's Bay and is approximately 30 minutes away.

## RESORT DRESS CODE

Ensure all guests are informed that gentlemen are required to wear collared shirt and trousers after 7:00pm in the main bar and dining area. Ladies dress accordingly. Footwear is also required in the main bar and dining area after 7:00pm (no flip flops).

## DRINKING WATER

Tap water is safe to drink and a wide range of mineral waters are available.

## SMOKING POLICY

The hotel respectfully requests that hotel guests do not smoke within any internal areas of the premises. There are a couple of designated smoking areas away from the main hotel facilities. Further details of this policy and the local regulations can be made available on request.

## JAMAICA INN TWO BEDROOM COTTAGES - Cottages 1, 2, 5 & 6

Four cottages are free-standing and set on the bluff overlooking the Caribbean Sea with spectacular panoramic views. The Cottages are private, tastefully decorated, and steps away from the hotel and all its amenities. Their oversized bathrooms feature separate shower and tub and marble floor. Each has an outdoor shower and an infinity plunge pool.

These are exclusively private with their own entrances to the sea. Cottage 6 consists of two bedrooms and two full bathrooms, one master oceanfront and a twin.
