FACTS ABOUT ST LUCIA

- St Lucia a small volcanic island in the [Caribbean](#) made up of one large and six smaller islands.
- The island is approximately 27 miles long and 14 miles wide and is just 238 square miles.
- The capital of Castries and some 60,000 people live in and around the capital and within the mainland with a further 100,000 people living around the coast of St Lucia.
- St Lucia is the first country to be named after a woman.
- The island gained independence from Britain in 1979.
- It is home to the Pitons mountain range which is a UNESCO World Heritage site.
- English is the official language of St Lucia with locals also speak Saint Lucian French Creole (Kwéyòl), which is colloquially referred to as Patois ("Patwa"), is spoken by 95% of the population.
- The population is of diverse ethnicity Around 85% of the population are thought to be direct descendants of Africans, while the remaining 15% is made up mainly of English, French, mixed African, and Indian.
- Known for the iconic Pitons mountain range, it has a drive-in volcano, 180 species of bird and 70% is covered in rainforest.

TRAVELLING TO ST LUCIA & EAST WINDS

LOCATION

East Winds is located on the Northwest coast of St Lucia, 1hr and 15 minutes by road from Hewanorra International Airport. The local airport at Castries, George F.L. Charles Airport (formerly known as Vigie) is a 15-minute drive away.

ACCESS

There are flights from the United Kingdom from London Gatwick and London Heathrow to St Lucia and from the USA, Canada and Europe and other international gateways. St Lucia is also serviced by inter-island carriers offering easy access from other Caribbean islands such as Barbados, Dominica, and Grenada.

CLIMATE

Average temperatures range from 75 degrees F to 85 degrees F (24 degrees C to 32 degrees C) the lowest temperatures occur between November and February. The climate is warm all year round, the dry season is between January and May and the rainy season is from June. Because of St Lucia's lush tropical vegetation, you can expect sporadic rainfall.

ST LUCIA ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Visitors must have a valid passport and return or onward ticket. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months from arrival into the country. However, if you are a British, Canadian or US citizen, proof of citizenship bearing a photograph is acceptable.

All visitors to the island must complete and submit the online St Lucian Electronic Entry Form up to 3 days before arrival.

AIRPORT LOCATIONS

Hewanorra International Airport (UVF) in Vieux Fort is located 40 miles south of Castries, the capital city. George F.L. Charles Airport is an inter-island airport just outside Castries.

EAST WINDS ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE SERVICES

Arrival - East Winds offers Fast Track VIP assistance on arrival at Hewanorra International Airport - guests are met by an agent escorted through Immigration and Customs. Once checked a porter will collect their luggage and escort them to the arrivals hall to be greeted by a Premier Concierge agent. VIP Guest passes can be arranged for clients departing St Lucia.

DEPARTURE - On the day of departure, the driver will drop the guests at the airport where Premiere Concierge agent meets guests and escorts them to the designated airline counter, assist with check-in and expedited through Immigration and security screening before proceeding to the VIP lounge.

Departure Package - includes canapés and drinks, free WiFi at US\$120 per couple - added to clients' final account on checkout.

Documentation Required

Full and valid passport.

Original birth certificate If either party is divorced - Decree Absolute.

If either party is widowed - death certificate of the deceased.

If a name has been changed by deed poll, proof will be required.

If either party is under the age of 18, evidence of consent of parents is required in the form of an affidavit stamped by a notary public.

Applications to marry are made through a local lawyer following 3 working days residency on St Lucia. East Winds will assist with this formality.

For something gentler and at sea level the Eastern Nature Trail along the Atlantic Coast is worth exploring as are many of the mapped nature trails the island features. There are ATV tours, zip lining, kayaking down the Roseau River, scuba and snorkeling, and kitesurfing excursions.

Boucanier Underwater Explorer - Only available to hotel guests.

This is a leisurely cruise of the west coast, exploring the main coral reef sites such as Anse Cochon, Anse Chastanet, the coral gardens by Gros Piton and Jalousie. You will have the opportunity to snorkel, swim and explore the dramatic coral reef walls that begin only a few feet from shore and drop off steeply into the ocean depths. There is an abundance of marine life and you may even see leatherback turtles.

Boucanier West Coast Raiding Party - Only available to hotel guests.

We leave the old port of Soufrière as buccaneers have done throughout the centuries to explore and raid the waters of the west coast. Pass the fishing villages of Canaries and Anse la Raye and Pigeon Island looms eventually on the horizon - on a clear day Martinique can also be seen. You can explore the island and take the opportunity to have a local lunch at Jambé De Bois waterfront restaurant and bar (named after the wooden-legged pirate who used this very place to ambush shipping in the days of sail). Later we sail to Marigot Bay, often described as the most beautiful bay in the Caribbean, and then on to anchor between the Pitons - one of the best and most dramatic mountain seascapes in the world, where you can take the opportunity to swim or just enjoy the views.

Soufrière Experience - Only available to hotel guests.

The Sulphur Springs, Diamond Falls & Gardens Tours - Visit the world's only drive-in volcano and sulphur springs en route to the picturesque waterfall at the Diamond Falls & Botanical Gardens. The pools at the mineral baths are filled with mineral-rich water that is naturally heated by volcanic activity, so take along bathing suits for a soothing dip. The rejuvenating powers of the water were recognised by the troops of Louis XIV who created the original mineral baths.

Gros Piton Climb - Only available to hotel guests.

Enjoy a breathtaking hike to the summit of Gros Piton. The first half of the trail is a gentle slope where the Caribbean Sea and the village of Choiseul can be seen to the south. The second half of the trail involves a steep ascent to the summit and is intended for the more adventurous hiker. This climb is approximately a 3- to 4-hour round trip. When you make it to the top, which is 2,619 feet above sea level, you have climbed one of Saint Lucia's iconic landmarks. This is a strenuous challenge and should be undertaken only by fit and agile hikers.

St Lucia's new multi-million-dollar state-of-the-art attraction which has a partnership with NOAA/NASA. Your guided tour of Our Planet will include eleven different educational spaces where visitors will discover more about St Lucia and the planet we live on.

Morne Coubaril Estate

This is an active plantation as well as tourist attraction. The zip line add-on offers breath-taking views of the Pitons and the quaint town of Soufriere. The working plantation tour is interactive and offers an engrossing taste of local history and culture.



ISLAND INFORMATION & ACTIVITIES

Pigeon Island National Park

Jutting out from the Northwest coast is Pigeon Island which is connected to the mainland by a causeway. Once upon a time this was a strategic point during the French and British struggles for control of St. Lucia. Now it's a national park and a venue for concerts, festivals, and family gatherings. There are two small beaches with calm waters for swimming and snorkelling, a restaurant, and lovely picnic areas.

Zion Lion Farm

It's not really a lion farm, more of a day trip encompassing a hike to Gros Piton from the beach, snorkelling in the Marine Reserve reefs, cooling off in the L'Ivrogne River's pools & waterfalls, exploring 18th-century sugar plantation & rum distillery ruins, horseback rides on the beach, and of course, enjoying an organic farm-to-table Carib Beach BBQ.

Horseback Riding with Island Riders

Explore St Lucia by horseback.

Diamond Falls Botanical Gardens

The Diamond Falls are consistently described as one of the natural wonders of St Lucia. Diamond Falls Botanical Gardens, a six-acre multi-award-winning tourism site, is a peaceful retreat from the outside world.

Rodney Bay

There's no shortage of things to do on this 80-acre man-made lagoon laden with restaurants, bars and shops.

La Soufriere

Drive-In Volcano There is nothing else like it in the world! You can literally drive right into the crater of this volcano and walk between the bubbling sulphur springs and hissing pools of steam.

Gros Islet Street Party
