# **TRAVELLING TO LITTLE GOOD HARBOUR & BARBADOS**

#### LOCATION

Within a peaceful little fishing community (a coastal hamlet known as 'Sherman's'). Little Good Harbour is on the site of historic Rupert Fort, dating back to the 17th century. The shopping amenities of Speightstown are only a short drive away. This hotel is just 45 minutes drive from the airport, 12km from Holetown and just 3km from Speightstown.

#### ACCESS

There are scheduled flights from London Gatwick and London Heathrow to Barbados and from the USA and other international gateways. Barbados is serviced by inter-island carriers offering easy access from other Caribbean islands such as Grenada, Antigua and St Lucia.

Direct scheduled services to Barbados from London with British Airways and Virgin Atlantic, plus Virgin Atlantic and Aer Lingus from Manchester during the winter months.

CLIMATE

Average temperatures range from 84 degrees F to 85 degrees F (27 degrees C) the lowest temperatures occur between November and February. The climate is warm all year round, the dry season is between January and May and the rainy season is from June to December.

UNITED KINGDOM

Flights from the United Kingdom to Grantley Adams International Airport, Barbados. British Airways / Virgin Atlantic Airways / TUI Airways Flying time - Approximately 8 hours outbound during the day and inbound to UK overnight.

**EUROPE - Germany** 

**Germany** - Condor - from Germany to Grantley Adams International Airport, Barbados. Flying time - Approximately 10 hours outbound during the day and inbound overnight.

USA

American Airlines / JetBlue / Delta Airlines / United Airlines Direct services from Miami approximately 3.5- hours. New York approximately 4.5-hours. There are flights from other US gateways with connections to Barbados.

CANADA

Air Canada / West Jet Flying time - Approximately 5.5 hours direct from Toronto and will differ from other Canadian cities.

Visitors must have a valid passport and return or onward ticket. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months from arrival into the country. However, if you are a British, Canadian or US citizen, proof of citizenship bearing a photograph is acceptable.

You will be met on arrival just off the tarmac at BGI and escorted swiftly through immigration and customs using a special Fast Track lane. This allows you to depart the airport within 40 minutes of landing. On your return, you are met on arrival at the airport, escorted to check in, then whisked through a private security lane and either straight to the VIP lounge or to the boarding gate.

An open-air covered terrace offers uninterrupted views of the Caribbean Sea, while the airy, informal dining rooms feature large picture windows facing toward the horizon. the Fish Pot Restaurant is an ideal setting for breakfast, lunch or dinner.

Reservations - Are essential to avoid disappointment, though priority is given to hotel guests.

Set within a historic fort on a pristine stretch of white sandy beach on the Caribbean Sea, <u>The Fish Pot Restaurant</u> provides a magical backdrop for Barbados wedding ceremonies and receptions. From an intimate celebration for two to an elegant dinner party, we can design a menu to suit all preferences and budgets. We work with our recommended partners to ensure every detail is taken care of, without the stress for the couple to enjoy an unforgettable day that's uniquely their own.

NUMBERS - Little Good Harbour can accommodate from 70-150 guests for a wedding service and celebration depending on the style of reception.

Legal Requirements

There is no official waiting period prior to the wedding ceremony. Couples must first go to the Ministry of Legal Affairs to obtain their Marriage Licence and the marriage can then take place (the Ministry is closed on Saturday, Sunday and Public Holidays). A letter will be obtained by the local agent, from the Marriage Officer stating that they will perform the wedding service.

#### The following documents are required:

Valid passports.

If divorced, the original Decree Absolute papers must be produced.

If widowed, the marriage certificate and partner's Death Certificate must be produced, unless the death certificate carries the name of the surviving partner.

If under 18 years of age, he/she must be accompanied by a parent.

If above documents are not in English, an official translation of these in English, must accompany the originals.

**Church Weddings** 

Weddings in church can be arranged at an additional charge. However, if guests request a Catholic wedding, two- or three-months' notice will be required as it is necessary for documentation to be prepared by the local church.

# Hunte's Gardens

Created by a legendary horticulturist with an unusual flair, Anthony Hunte, these extraordinary gardens will flabbergast even the most keen gardeners and enthusiasts.

#### St. Nicholas Abbey

Built in the mid-1650s, is one of the few Jacobean-style houses left in the Western Hemisphere and one of the oldest buildings on the island. This elegant home was also a working sugar plantation during the days of slavery and many of its working buildings remain.

#### Soup Bowl, Bathsheba

A surfer's paradise – This beach has consistent and sizeable waves and is best known for its unique shaped rocks and terrain, with surf school for all levels of experience.

There are approximately 70 miles (110 km) of beaches pink and white sands numbering some 80 in total take time to explore the island and beach hop

Golf

Barbados has several golf courses to choose from and the premier three are within 15 minutes' drive from Little Good Harbour.

Oistins

One of its main attractions is the Oistins Fish Fry, a weekly event held on Friday and Saturday nights, where locals and tourists gather to enjoy fresh seafood, live music, and a festive atmosphere.
