

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## Personal Viewpoint

We feel Little Good Harbour offers something a little different, particularly due to its location away from the bustle of the ever-developing West Coast. The historical aspect is certainly part of the appeal of the property, and the original 17th century fort has been carefully and tastefully restored to create the restaurant and bar as well as two of the hotel's luxury suites.

The other buildings which house the One- and Two- Bedroom Suites are delightful, designed as Caribbean-style guest cottages and very in keeping with the surrounding environment. The Vineyard Suites offer villa-style accommodation to discerning guests seeking a relaxed resort. Sister hotel The Atlantis Historic Inn offers chic suites with a delicious restaurant. Perfect for a short break from the West Coast.









#### How to get there

Direct scheduled services to Barbados from London with British Airways and Virgin Atlantic, plus Virgin Atlantic from Manchester.

#### Location

Within a peaceful little fishing community (a coastal hamlet known as 'Sherman's'). Little Good Harbour is on the site of historic Rupert Fort, dating back to the 17th century. The shopping amenities of Speightstown are only a short drive away. This hotel is just one hour's drive from the airport, 12km from Holetown and just 3km from Speightstown.

#### Accommodation

20 luxury Villa Suites are comprised of six 3-Bedroom Vineyard Garden Suites, one 3-Bedroom Ocean Fort Suite, one 2-Bedroom Ocean Fort Suite, three 2-Bedroom Garden Suites and nine 1-Bedroom Garden Suites. (Refer to page 6 for full descriptions).

The 2-Bedroom Fort Suite has been completely refurbished.

Government Room Levy of US\$4.38 per Bedroom per night is payable locally.

#### **Airport Transfers**

Transfers from the Airport to the Hotel = US\$75 each way per car, max. 2 persons (approx. subject to amount of luggage), or US\$90 each way. max. 4 persons.

#### Babysittina

This can be arranged locally. Charge approx. US\$10 per hour.

#### Check-in/ Check-out

Rooms are available from 3:00pm and guests are asked to vacate their rooms by 12:00noon.

#### Children

Children are welcome year-round.

#### Climate

Delightful year-round. Average temperature 27°C (84°F), with the dry season mid-December to May.

#### **Credit Cards**

The hotel accepts Visa and MasterCard. There is a 2% tax added onto hotel bills when paying by credit, debit and travel cards.

#### Currency

Barbados dollar (tied to the US dollar). US dollars, sterling and Euros are readily accepted.

#### **Dress Code**

Dress for dinner is casual/elegant. Camouflage/para-military apparel is illegal in many Caribbean islands including Barbados.

#### **Drivers Licence**

A temporary registration licence can be obtained on presentation of a full and valid UK licence - cost BD\$10.

#### **Electricity**

110 volts/50 cycles.

#### **Hotel Facilities**

- Fish Pot Restaurant and bar
- Two freshwater swimming pools
- Beach access, loungers & umbrellas, complimentary use of kayaks and snorkelling equipment, flagged beach drink service
- Exercise room including a treadmill and cross-trainer
- The Little Spa
- Yacht Charters sunset dinner and day cruises available on the luxury catamaran 'Seaduced' directly from the hotel dock. Full details are available on request.

#### Meals

Breakfast, lunch and dinner are à la carte at the beachfront restaurant *The Fish Pot*, with local and international dishes that are fresh, healthy and tasty, plus an extensive selection of fine wines. The Fish Pot was extended and renovated in Autumn 2019 with state-of-the-art kitchens and extended seating and terrace for drinks.

Reservations are essential to avoid disappointment, though priority is given to hotel guests.

Alternatively, meals can be prepared in-suite by a local cook from approx. US\$50 plus cost of food.

Breakfast: 8.00am – 10.00am Lunch: 12:00noon – 2.30pm Dinner: 5.30pm – 9.30pm

Room service: Limited service available between 9:00 am and 9:00pm and is subject to weather conditions at time of request, due to the layout of the property.

New local restaurant 'The Sea Shed' in nearby Mullins Beach is also popular with Little Good Harbour guests.

#### **Number of Suites**

20 (2 are beach front, 12 are in the garden and pool area and 6 are higher up with separate shared pool and gardens).

#### Facilities in Each Suite

All suites have a separate living room with French doors leading out to a terrace or balcony. All offer air conditioning (bedroom only), ceiling fans, hair dryers, iron and ironing board, stereo with iPod docking station, cable TV in the bedroom and fully equipped kitchen.

1/2-Bedroom Garden Suites and 2/3-Bedroom Ocean Fort Suites: Fully equipped kitchens furnished with fridge, oven and microwave. Dishwasher is available in the 3-Bedroom Fort Suite. Queen 4-poster beds in master bedrooms (king size in 3-Bedroom Suite), twin beds in second bedroom of the 2-Bedroom Suite and third bedroom of 3-Bedroom Suite (queen bed in second bedroom of 3-Bedroom Suite), each bedroom has a spacious en-suite bathroom with private shower, bathrobes & slippers.

3-Bedroom Vineyard Garden Suites: Each suite is 2,175 sq. ft. 3 bedrooms, (master bedroom – 1 king bed / 2nd bedroom 2 single beds / 3rd bedroom 1 queen bed) 3 bathrooms, a large tiled verandah encompassing the dining and outdoor areas and breakfast bar, TV and fully equipped kitchen (oven, hob and hood, fridge/freezer, dishwasher, washer/dryer). The master suite has separate bath and shower, with spacious showers in the remaining two bedrooms.

#### 1-Bedroom Garden Suite

9 suites in 5 semi-detached villa-style cottages (situated behind the three 2-Bedroom Garden Suites) on the land side from the Fort/restaurant. All suites are on 2 levels with the living room, kitchen and patio downstairs, and the bedroom and bathroom upstairs, with a terrace. Twin beds are not possible in 1-Bedroom Suites. The rooms all come with a queen 4-poster bed

Maximum occupancy: 2 persons (plus one extra child under 16 on a rollaway bed).







#### 2-Bedroom Garden Suite

3 suites in detached villa-style cottages in the gardens across a minor road from the Fort/restaurant and situated near the swimming pool. 1 suite is on 2 levels with the main bedroom upstairs and second bedroom downstairs adjacent to the living room. The other 2 suites are on one level with a bedroom either side of the living room. Each bedroom has its own en-suite bathroom. All suites have a large terrace with dining table and chairs.

Maximum occupancy: 4 persons (plus one extra or child under 16 on a rollaway bed).



#### 2-Bedroom Ocean Fort Suite

Beautifully refurbished with new stylish bathrooms, tropical décor and gorgeous views of the Caribbean Sea. Both bedrooms are en-suite, each with king-sized beds (the second bedroom can be converted into 2 singles). +/- 2,500 sq. ft. This suite is located on the upper level above the restaurant and bar area, on the water's edge directly overlooking the beach and the sea, with its own private roof top terrace, which is furnished for relaxing and all fresco dining.

Maximum occupancy: 4 persons (plus one extra child under 16 on a rollaway bed).







#### 3-Bedroom Ocean Fort Suite

This spacious beachfront suite situated adjacent to the restaurant, is part of the original fort building with private terrace, garden and immediate beach access. Maximum occupancy: 6 persons.








#### 3-Bedroom Vineyard Suites

6 luxurious suites in 3 new buildings situated on the upper terrace of the garden. Whilst distinctly tropical they offer high quality European elegance with a traditional Caribbean design. Great living space, sexy décor in neutral shades, with hard wood polished floors and pickled wood or spacious patios with living and dining areas. Each suite is named after wines from the Margaret River region of Western Australia – a connection with the family that own Little Good Harbour.

**Upstairs suites:** Frog Choir, Driftwood and Moondance (no rollaway beds permitted).

Ground floor suites: Leeuwin, Voyager and Leaping Lizard. Maximum occupancy: 6 persons.





#### Little Good Harbour Special Wedding Package

Little Good Harbour can arrange for a local wedding coordinator for guests to plan and execute a simple affair for 2 or a more extravagant event.

Cost: Starting at US\$1900

#### What's Included:

- Fast-track passes through Barbados airport for two people
- Airport transfers
- Welcome drink on arrival at the hotel
- Bottle of prosecco in room on arrival
- Wedding ceremony provided by Wedding Coordinator
- Complete assistance to the Bride & Groom
- Return transfer from Little Good Harbour to Ministry of Home Affairs and assistance with application process
- All legal fees and stamp fees for marriage certificate
- Beach/hotel wedding at Little Good Harbour
- Magistrate
- Two witnesses
- Bamboo arch with drapes and fresh flowers in colour of choice
- Signing table
- 1-tier Wedding Cake in Vanilla or Chocolate
- Sand ceremony vase keepsake
- Tropical bridal bouquet and boutonnière (incorporating their colour/s of choice)

- Marriage certificate and photos will be delivered or posted to the couple

#### **Legal Requirements**

There is no official waiting period prior to the wedding ceremony. Couples must first go to the Ministry of Legal Affairs to obtain their Marriage Licence and the marriage can then take place (the Ministry is closed on Saturday, Sunday and Public Holidays). A letter will be obtained by the local agent, from the Marriage Officer stating that they will perform the wedding service.

The following documents are required:

- Valid passports
- If divorced, the original Decree Absolute papers must be produced
- If widowed, the marriage certificate and partner's Death Certificate must be produced, unless the death certificate carries the name of the surviving partner
- If under 18 years of age, he/she must be accompanied by a parent
- If above documents are not in English, an official translation of these in English, must accompany the originals

#### Church Weddings

Weddings in church can be arranged at an additional charge. However, if guests request a Catholic wedding, two- or three-months' notice will be required as it is necessary for documentation to be prepared by the local church.









## A Day in the Life of a Guest at Little Good Harbour



With the Fish Pot Restaurant across the way, begin your day with a sumptuous breakfast.



Hire a jeep and discover Barbados' capital, Bridgetown in the Southwest corner of the island. Explore a little further and have lunch at sister hotel, The Atlantis Historic Inn, situated on the dramatic East Coast.



After a delicious lunch at The Fish Pot, take a stroll through the gardens to the Little Spa and indulge in a full body scrub and massage.



Plan an afternoon activity. Watersports and golf can be arranged locally by the hotel – just ask at reception and they will be happy to assist. You could also opt for a catamaran day trip or sunset cruise from the hotel's dock.



On Friday at 5pm, the local Fishermen bring their catch of the day to the village next to Little Good Harbour and so why not enjoy a delicious Fish Fry - the local event of the week.



Despite the amazing choice of gourmet West Coast restaurants in Barbados, the Fish Pot is one of the best for dinner. A complete contrast, though, would be to drive to the Fish Market, just 5 minutes up the road, where 'fish of the day' with rice and peas is available for just a few dollars. If eating out is not your 'thing', a local cook can be booked to make you a delicious meal in the comfort of your own suite.

#### **Hunte's Gardens**

#### Golf

Barbados has several golf courses to choose from and the premier three are within 15 minutes' drive from Little Good Harbour.

#### St. Nicholas Abbey

Built in the mid-1650s, is one of the few Jacobean-style houses left in the Western Hemisphere and one of the oldest buildings on the island. This elegant home was also a working sugar plantation during the days of slavery and many of its working buildings remain.

#### Soup Bowl, Bathsheba

A surfer's paradise – This beach has consistent and sizeable waves and is best known for its unique shaped rocks and terrain.

#### Mount Gay Rum Refinery

Mount Gay is the oldest rum refinery in the world, so be sure not to leave the island without sampling some of this famous delicious rum!

#### Kensington Oval, Bridgetown

Once the grounds of a plantation house, this stadium is well known for its historic cricket matches and entertaining atmosphere.
